Trinity County Launches Integrated Emergency Alert System and Platform

ReadyTrinity to Serve as Official Emergency Notification and Information Hub

Weaverville, CA (May 6, 2025) – The Trinity County Office of Emergency Services (OES) is excited to announce the launch of its new emergency alert system and platform, ReadyTrinity (ReadyTrinity.org). ReadyTrinity offers significant enhancements to how the County communicates critical information to residents during emergencies, and features a robust website that will serve as a hub for critical, timely information during emergencies and disasters, and an ongoing resource for prevention, response, and hazard information.

The ReadyTrinity alert system provides improved functionality, enabling the OES to deliver more timely and precise alerts, ensuring residents receive the information they need to stay safe and informed.

"The ReadyTrinity program represents a significant investment in the safety and well-being of our community," said Liz Hamilton, Director, Trinity County Office of Emergency Services. "This emergency alert system will empower us to communicate more effectively during emergencies, providing residents with critical information to help them make informed decisions."

ReadyTrinity will be used to inform residents about a range of emergencies, including:

- Wildfires
- Severe Weather Events
- Dam Failure
- Floods
- Earthquakes

- Law Enforcement Incidents
- Public Health Crises
- Evacuations
- And other critical community alerts

Trinity County OES strongly encourages all residents to register for ReadyTrinity to receive these vital notifications. Registration is free and easy, and residents can sign up by visiting ReadyTrinity.org from a computer or mobile device and following the prompts to register.

"We urge all Trinity County residents to take a few minutes to register for ReadyTrinity," added Hamilton. "Being prepared is essential, and this system will provide you with the information you need to protect yourself, your family, and your property."
